STATEMENT OF FACTS

THE FACTS

*Conditions of detention in a remand prison*

Between 24 February 2005 and 9 August 2006 the applicant was held in remand prison IZ-66/1 in the Sverdlovskiy Region. The prison was overcrowded. Thus, cell 327 measuring 30 sq. m was equipped with 18 sleeping places and accommodated up to 33 inmates; cell 640 measuring 30 sq. m was designed for 12 and housed up to 24 individuals; furthermore, cell 653 measuring 12 sq. m presented 6 places and up to 21 detainees who occupied them.

*Other relevant facts*

The applicant's incoming and outgoing correspondence with his family has been subject to censorship.

COMPLAINT(S)

The applicant complains, among other matters, under Article 3 of the Convention about the conditions of detention.

The applicant complains under Article 8 of the Convention about unlawful and disproportionate interference with his correspondence.
